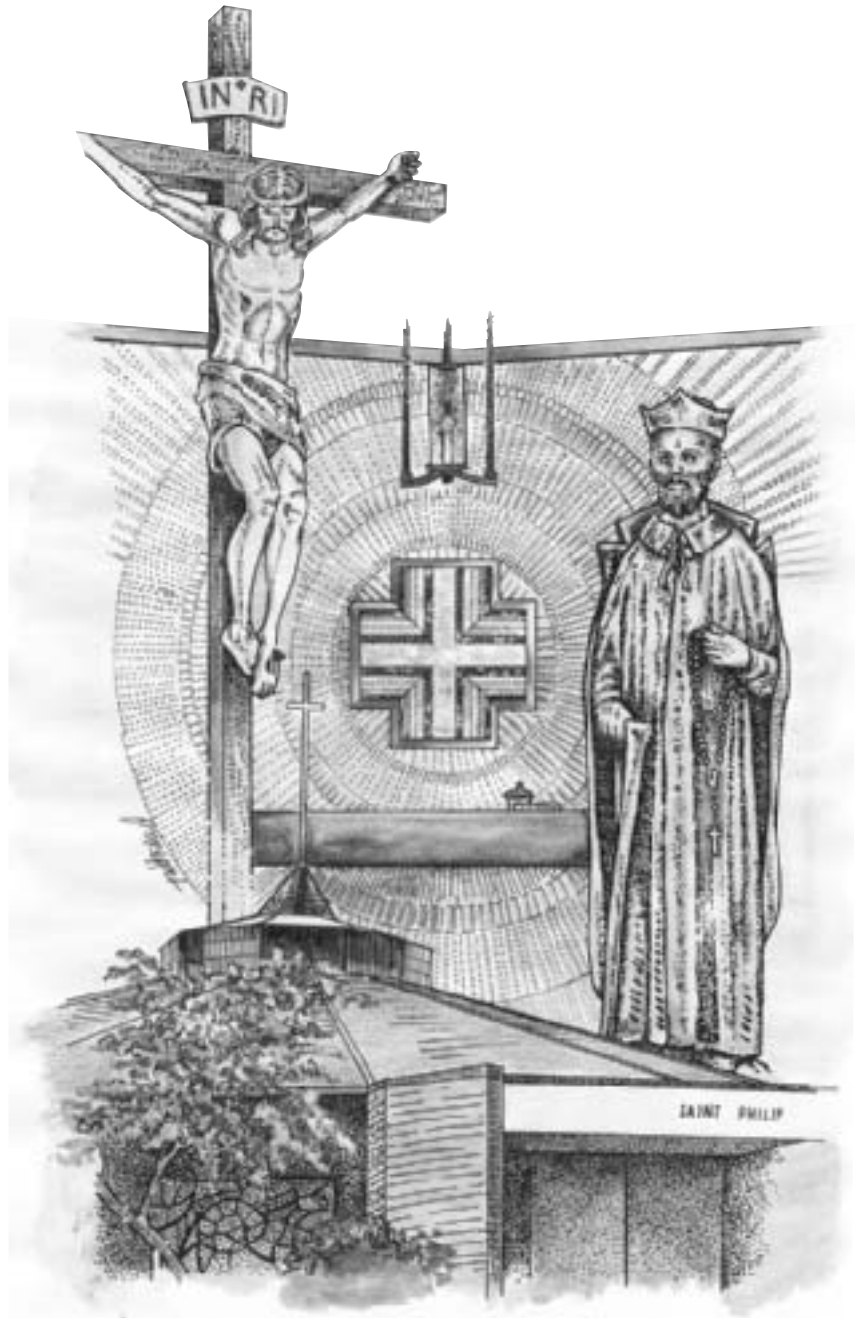

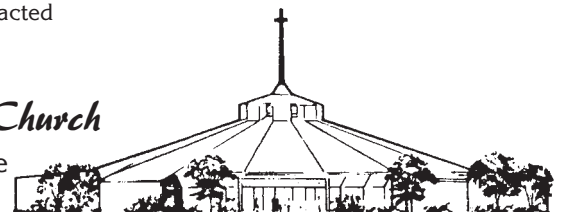

LENT AND EASTER REGULATIONS

“Lent runs from *Ash Wednesday* thru *Holy Saturday*”.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT IS TO BE OBSERVED BY ALL CATHOLICS 14 YEARS OR OLDER ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT. The determination of certain days as obligatory days of penance should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance. The spirit of the season of Lent should be maintained throughout the weeks of Lent. The obligation to observe penitential days of the Church is serious. Failure to observe individual days of penance is not necessarily considered serious. No one should be scrupulous in this regard.

People should seek to do more rather than less, since fast and abstinence on the days prescribed should be considered a minimal response to the Lord’s call to penance and conversion of life.
