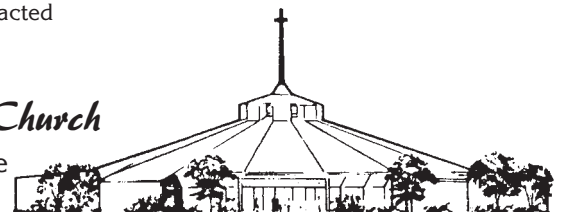

**EDUCATIONAL DRIVE AND SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN
TO BAN HUMAN CLONING IN LOUISIANA**

The Archdiocesan Respect Life Office, Louisiana Conference of Catholic Bishops, Louisiana Right to Life and many other pro-life, pro-family groups in the state have worked tirelessly to protect our smallest brothers and sisters, the human embryo.

A **petition signature campaign** will be held in our parish this weekend **April 26 –27** and next weekend, **May 3-4**. After all Masses both weekends, petitions will be available for signature at the Porte-Cochere entrance (outside) and the Olympic Street entrance (outside) of the Church. Louisiana Right to Life and its member chapters will be delivering the Petitions to the Governor and members of the legislature.

Excerpts from a letter received from *Most Reverend Alfred C. Hughes*, Archbishop of New Orleans.

"We have a Governor deeply committed to the protection of human life at its earliest stages and we have a legislative body that we believe will pass this ban.

Recent scientific breakthroughs have created embryonic-like stem cells without destroying the human embryo. We are very hopeful that this new and promising technique will totally abolish the need for the creation of human embryos for their destruction.

Louisiana has had a long tradition of laws that protect and defend human life from conception until natural death. We now need to ensure that human life is never created for destructive, harmful experimentation."
