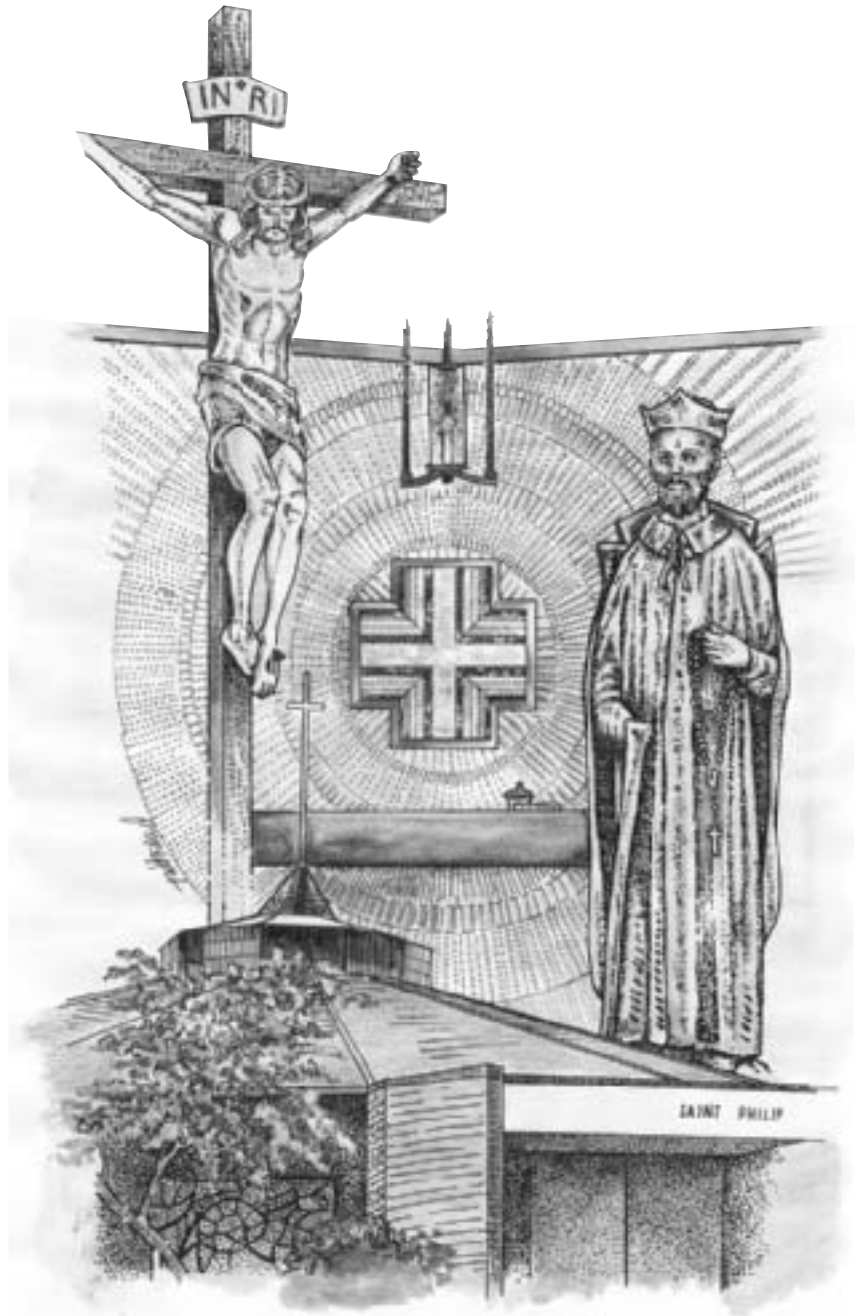

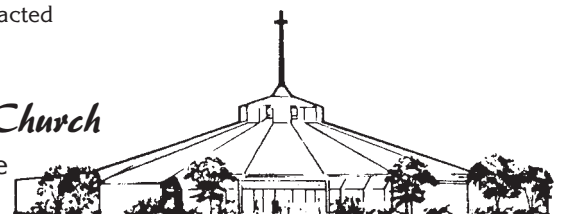

APRIL IS CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH *Preventing Child Abuse Is Everyone's Responsibility.*

Our Safe Environment Program is incorporated into the on-going mission of the Archdiocese of New Orleans. We will ensure that children who worship, study, and participate in activities sponsored by the Archdiocese can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible.

Five Steps To Safer Environments

1. It is every adult's responsibility to protect minors by reporting suspected abuse or neglect to the responsible authorities. Know the numbers of the local agencies who investigate suspected abuse or neglect of minors.
2. Parents and guardians who are involved in parish/school programs will be in the best position to protect their own children as well as all children in the community.
3. Make sure your children have a strong username (ideally alphanumeric) and password that doesn't reveal any personal information.
4. Be aware of and sensitive to what is going on in the lives of your children.
5. Always observe the behaviors of those who interact with children— in parish, school, parties, neighborhood.

Do you know where your parish, school and organization rosters are in your home?

Be aware of personal information pertaining to your child and other children that you have in your homes.

Is there a list on the kitchen counter?

Is there a list on the refrigerator?

Is there a list on your desk?

Is a list on your computer without a protected password?

Protect all personal information from visitors and workers who come in and out of your homes as well as contact information you may put on your computer where others may have access to it.
