WHAT IS R.C.I.A.?

The initials stand for **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**. In the **R.C.I.A.**, one embarks on a journey of Faith, fellowship and prayer designed for adults who would like to learn (or even re-learn) the basic tenets of Catholicism in an atmosphere that is warm, supportive, and friendly. For some, this journey will take them to the Easter vigil, where they will be welcomed into the full communion of the Roman Catholic Church through the sacraments of *Baptism, Confirmation* and *Eucharist*.

Sessions are led by **Deacon Ed**, and assisted by fellow SPN parishioners. The key part of each period is devoted to topics and issues central to Catholicism. Another part of the session is spent on the liturgy for the day, understanding its background and discussing its message for the Church and for each of us. "Class time" is informal, relaxed and there are no pop quizzes.

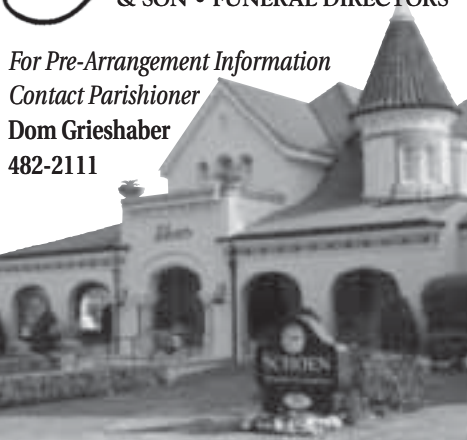
