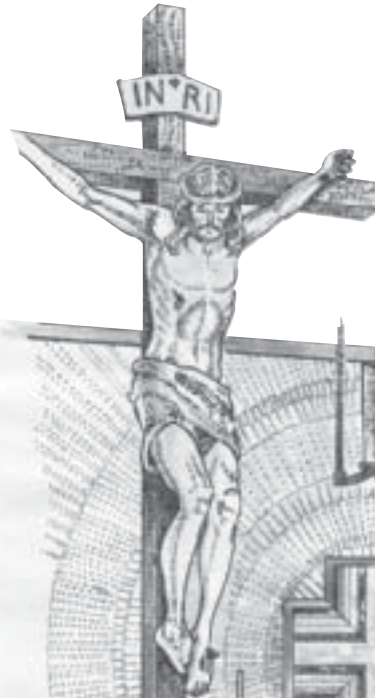

LORD, TEACH ME TO PRAY...

Lord, Teach Me To Pray is a three part Ignatian prayer series developed to meet the desire of women for on-going spiritual growth, as they respond to the call to holiness and to a deeper commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord. It was developed as an outreach program to bring the Holy Spirit into the daily lives of women in facilitated faith-sharing prayer communities, where the Lord, himself teaches them to pray.

Part 1: Praying Christian Virtues: Praying Christian Virtues will introduce you to the meditative and contemplative way of prayer devised by St. Ignatius of Loyola, enabling you to further develop your prayer life. This 12 week program is facilitated in a group setting, meets for 2 hours once a week, and requires fifteen minutes of daily prayer on assigned scriptures. (No prerequisites) Classes: *Parishioners' Center*, Wednesday evenings, 7:00 PM, beginning Sept 15.

Part 2: My 19th Annotation: This communal approach allows you to do the full Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola. You will pray for all the graces that are offered while experiencing the direction of the Holy Spirit through weekly Faith Sharing on your daily prayer. This 30 week program is facilitated in a group setting, meets for 2 hours once a week, and requires thirty to forty-five minutes of daily prayer on assigned scriptures. (Part 1 is a prerequisite.) Please call for details.

Part 3: Discernment & Gifts of the Spirit: Through catechesis on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, praying St. Ignatius's Rules of Discernment, and weekly Faith Sharing on your daily prayer, you will experience the grace of growing in sensitivity to God's presence, enabling you to become more responsive to His daily call. This 14 week program is facilitated in a group setting, meets for 2 hours once a week, and requires forty-five to sixty minutes of daily prayer on assigned scriptures. (Parts 1 and 2 are prerequisites.) Classes: *Parishioners' Center*, Wednesday mornings, 10:00 AM, beginning Sept 15.

R.C.I.A. CLASSES

The first 2010-2011 R.C.I.A. Class will take place on Sunday, September 19th, 9:00AM-11:00AM, in the Conference Room of the *Parishioners' Center*.

WHAT IS R.C.I.A.?

The initials stand for **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**. In the R.C.I.A., one embarks on a journey of Faith, fellowship and prayer designed for adults who would like to learn (or even re-learn) the basic tenets of Catholicism in an atmosphere that is warm, supportive, and friendly. For some, this journey will take them to the Easter vigil, where they will be welcomed into the full communion of the Roman Catholic Church through the sacraments of *Baptism, Confirmation* and *Eucharist*.

Sessions are led by *Deacon Ed*, and assisted by fellow SPN parishioners. The key part of each period is devoted to topics and issues central to Catholicism. Another part of the session is spent on the liturgy for the day, understanding its background and discussing its message for the Church and for each of us. "Class time" is informal, relaxed and there are no pop quizzes.

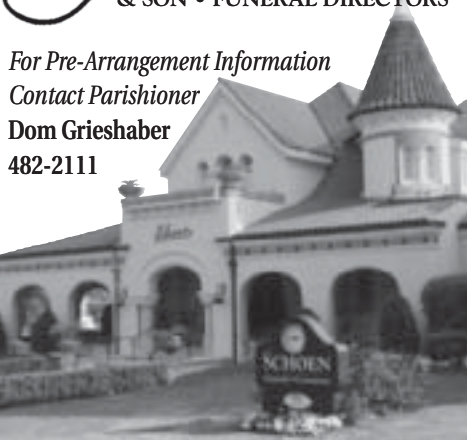
