The Great “O” Antiphons of Advent

In the Church’s Liturgy of the Hours, Evening Prayer, Vespers, includes the Magnificat. Each day, the Magnificat is preceded by a short verse or “antiphon.” In the last seven days of Advent, December 17-24, the antiphons before the Magnificat are very special. Each begins with the exclamation “O” and ends with a plea for the Messiah to come.

These moving “O Antiphons” were composed in the seventh or eighth century when monks put together texts from the Old Testament, particularly from the prophet Isaiah, which looked forward to the coming of our salvation. They form a rich, interlocking mosaic of scriptural images. The great “O Antiphons” became very popular in the Middle Ages when it became traditional to ring the great bells of the church each evening as they were being sung.

Each of the “O Antiphons” highlights a different title for the Messiah: O Sapientia (O Wisdom), O Adonai (O Lord), O Radix Jesse (O Root of Jesse), O Clavis David (O Key of David), O Oriens (O Rising Sun), O Rex Gentium (O King of the Nations), and O Emmanuel.

Saying the O Antiphons as a family, whether during grace at meals, in front of the manger scene, or in front of the Christmas tree, is a wonderful Advent devotion. To make this devotion more fruitful, read and meditate together on the Scripture texts on which the antiphons are based.

December 17th: O Sapientia (Isaiah 11:2-3, 28-29): “O Wisdom, you come forth from the mouth of the Most High. You fill the universe and hold all things together in a strong yet gentle manner. O come to teach us the way of truth.”

December 18th: O Adonai (Isaiah 11:4-5, 33:22): “O Adonai and leader of Israel, you appeared to Moses in a burning bush and you gave him the Law on Sinai. O come and save us with your mighty power.”

December 19th: O Radix Jesse (Isaiah 11:1, 10): “O stock of Jesse, you stand as a signal for the nations; kings fall silent before you whom the prophets acclaim. O come to deliver us, and do not delay.”

December 20th: O Clavis David (Isaiah 9:6, 22:22): “O key of David and scepter of Israel, what you open no one else can close again; what you close no one can open. O come to lead the captive from prison, free those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death.”

December 21st: O Oriens (Isaiah 9:1): “O Rising Sun, you are the splendor of eternal light and the sun of justice. O come and enlighten those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death.”

December 22nd: O Rex Gentium (Isaiah 2:4, 9:5): “O King whom all the peoples desire, you are the cornerstone which makes all one. O come and save man whom you made from clay.”

December 23rd: O Emmanuel (Isaiah 7:14): “O Emmanuel, you are our king and judge, the One whom the peoples await and their Savior. O come and save us, Lord our God.”

COMING SOON → SPIRITUAL ADOPTION PROGRAM

Because January 22 is the 39th Anniversary of Roe v Wade which legalized abortion, SPN’s Respect Life Ministry is excited to announce that on the weekend of **January 21 & 22, 2012** our parish will have the opportunity to participate in a Spiritual Adoption Program! We encourage everyone to join together in a parish wide effort to increase our prayers to end the evil of abortion.

All you have to do to participate is *pray* for an unborn baby who may be in danger of being aborted and to pray also for the mother of that baby. You will not even know who the mother is, but you will give that baby a *name*, thereby giving that baby the humanity he or she deserves. Each of you may *spiritually adopt* a baby, or your family as a whole, your classroom or your Cub Scout Troup, etc.

On January 21 and Sunday January 22, if you wish to participate, you will be given a special Prayer Flyer on which you will *write the name* of your spiritually adopted baby. Each month for the next 9 months an updated report on the Developmental Progress of your *spiritually adopted* baby will be published in our church bulletin.

On October 6 & 7, 2012, *Respect Life Sunday* (the ninth month of pregnancy), *your baby will be born* and our parish will rejoice by having a Baby Shower! You will then be asked to bring a Baby gift (diapers, diaper wipes, infant clothes, crib sheets, blankets, baby bottles, layette items etc) to our church on that weekend. These gifts will be given to the Access Program of Catholic Charities which will distribute them to the women they counsel in their crisis pregnancy program.


