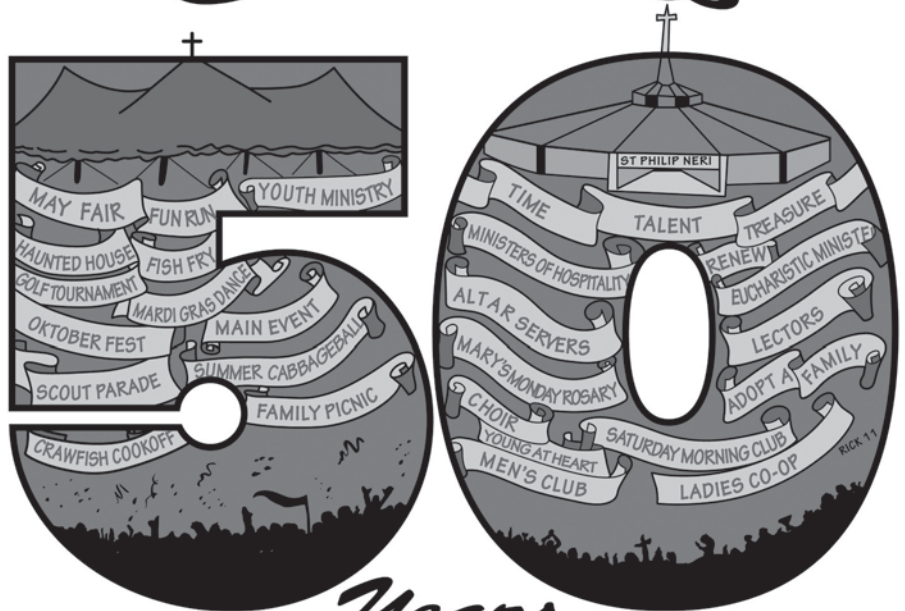

Biography of...*Bishop Carmon*

Dominic Carmon, a native of Opelousas, Louisiana, pursued studies in higher education at Divine Word seminaries in Illinois, Iowa and Mississippi and DePaul University in Chicago. He was ordained a priest in the Society of the Divine Word on February 2, 1960.

He began his priestly ministry as an assistant pastor of Saint Anselm Church in Chicago, Illinois. Then he served as a missionary in the Diocese of Wewak in Papua New Guinea for seven years. In 1969 he returned to Chicago as pastor of Saint Elizabeth Church where he served for fifteen years. In June 1984 he was transferred to Our Lady of the Gardens Parish, also in Chicago. In December of 1988 he was appointed pastor of Holy Ghost Church in Opelousas, Louisiana.

On December 16, 1992, he was appointed Titular Bishop of Ruscade and Auxiliary Bishop of New Orleans by Pope John Paul II.

In addition to his regular duties as Auxiliary Bishop and Vicar General, Bishop Carmon served the Archdiocese of New Orleans as pastor of Saint Frances Cabrini Church in New Orleans for four and a half years, and was pastor of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Church in Kenner for nine years.

On Bishop Carmon's 76<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2006, Pope Benedict XVI accepted his request for retirement. In retirement he continues to assist the Archdiocese of New Orleans with Confirmations and various other ministries. On March 25, 2011 Archbishop Gregory Aymond appointed him to serve as Administrator of St. Philip Neri Parish in Metairie until the appointment of a new pastor.

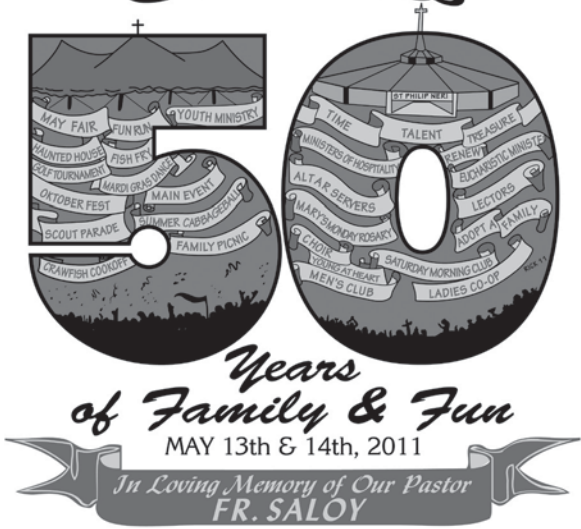


