This group brings Holy Communion to those parishioners who are homebound due to illness or accident, and thus not able to fully participate in the celebration of the Mass. Members of this ministry visit with and pray with those parishioners during their confinement, whether the physical restriction is temporary or long-term. This important ministry serves to keep the homebound parishioner close to his/her spiritual roots and Catholic faith. To receive this service, all that is needed is a phone call to the Church Office.

**ROMAN MISSAL, THIRD EDITION**

Each week our bulletin will include information pertaining to the use of the new translation of the Roman Missal, which we will begin using, the First Sunday of Advent.

**2. Who is doing the work of translation?**

The process of translating liturgical texts from the original Latin is a highly consultative work done by several groups. The International Commission on English in the Liturgy (ICEL) prepares English translations of liturgical texts on behalf of the conferences of bishops of English-speaking countries. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and the other member conferences receive draft translations of each text and have the opportunity to offer comments and suggestions to ICEL. Then ICEL proposes a second draft, which each conference approves and submits to the Vatican for final approval. Each conference reserves the right to amend or modify a particular text.

At the Vatican, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments examines the translated texts, offers authoritative approval (*recognitio*) of the texts, and grants permission for their use. Currently the Congregation is aided by the recommendations of Vox Clara, a special committee of bishops and consultants from English-speaking countries. The translation and review process is guided by the guidelines in *Liturgiam Authenticam*, issued in 2001, an instruction from the Congregation that outlines the principles and rules for liturgical translation. In 2007, the Congregation also issued a *ratio* outlining the specific rules for translation in English.

**HURRICANE DISASTER SUPPLY LIST:**

- Keep all prescription medication in original containers. A minimum, of a 2-week supply is recommended. Have a copy of prescription, if possible.
- List of doctors and relatives/friends who should be notified in case of injury.
- Medical insurance cards, social security card, birth certificate, and any other legal documents that will assist you in relocating elsewhere.
- Change of clothing, shoes, and underclothes (at least a 3-day supply).
- Personal hygiene items.
- List of medical devices with serial numbers and style (ex. Pacemakers, oxygen).
- Extra pair of eyeglasses and hearing aid batteries.
- Cash, credit cards, change for pay phones.
- Non-perishable food supply, including any special foods you require that can be stored and carried. (Include a manual can opener).
- Paper plates, cups, plastic forks, knives, spoons, aluminum foil and zip lock bags.
- Bottled water (1 gallon per person) - 3-day supply.
- First Aid Kit.
- Pillow and blanket.
- Flashlight and battery-powered radio/extra batteries.
- Plastic garbage bags with ties.
- Disinfectant, bleach and hand sanitizer

**ZIP-LOCK BAG TO GO :**

**(Make copies and put in a waterproof bag.)**

- Social Security Cards, Birth Certificates, Marriage & Death Certificates.
- Driver's Licenses or Legal ID.
- Wills, Deeds, Mortgages & Leases.
- Titles & Registrations for vehicles, boats, campers/travel vehicles.
- Inventory of Household Goods by photo or videotape.
- Important Account Numbers and Contact Information for bank accounts, checking & savings; credit cards (with photocopies of all cards carried in wallet); medical insurance; mortgage loan & lender.
- Insurance Policy Numbers, Agency or Agent Contact Information for homeowners; flood; auto; medical; life; death/burial.
- Medical records/children's vaccination histories.
- Backup disks of computer information.
