Approval of Minutes

Fr. Saloy's Update:

Father read a letter from a parishioner who wants to bring to Sunday Mass a puppy which is being trained as a guide dog. Father was concerned about possible law suits but the Archdiocesan attorneys felt the parishioner should be allowed to bring the dog. The council recommended that an announcement be made in both the bulletin and during Mass prior to the dog's first visit warning that the dog was in training and should not be petted.
