**New Business**

The plaque in memory of Father Saloy is being created. It will be unveiled on March 31, 2012, on the anniversary of his death.

40 Days for Life: There will be parishioners present at the abortion clinic from 7:00 am. to 7:00 pm. The Archbishop has requested prayers and penance throughout the 40 days.

Upcoming events: On November 9, there will be a memorial Mass for everyone who has lost a family member during the past year. On October 9, St. Philip Neri will host a liturgy for those with disabilities. Disabled members from Family Life will serve in various liturgical ministries.

**Other Business**

The license for the program for children two years old and younger has been revoked by the state because of technical problems with the timing of submission of employee fingerprints. All of the children have been placed in neighboring parishes. Parents will not be charged more

for those programs than they were to be charged at St. Philip. We have asked the state court to relook at the case but, in the event that they do not, we can reapply in two years.

Father would like to start a Family Life Ministry at St. Philip. He will be seeking people who might be interested in helping with programs dealing with all aspects of family life.

Father will present a parish financial report to the parishioners in the near future.
